HPP COVID-19 Funds

- Discussion and input regarding COVID 19 additional funding of \$25,000 . The HCC has until June 2021 to spend these funds. PPE was discussed that it would be a good fit for these funds focusing on Home Health, LTC, Behavioral Health. Dr. Weber indicated that this would be good usage of extra funding and asked if there was a shelf life on PPE. Discussion on shelf life of gloves, N95's. Dr. Weber indicated there is a good chance the HCC would have these supplies on hand for quite some time. The HCC would need to look at storage, rotation, ect. An HCC member agency, Center Toward Self Reliance, 719-546-1271, has indicated the HCC could use their storage space at the lumber yard at the Mid Town Shopping Center in Pueblo. Lori will confirm. The most requested items discussed were, N95 masks, gloves and gowns. Paul indicated he has a service that can provide some of these supplies. The State stockpile is very depleted. Vaccines will go directly to the LPHA's, not the SNS. Gowns were discussed that can be laundered, thus cutting down on trying to get disposable gowns.
- It was agreed by the CPT to move forward with PPE to some extent and look at what the regional as a whole might need.
- Funding Part 2 - \$85,000 per HCC plus \$3000 per hospital. Suggestions included projects, PPE, hiring another person to assist with mass communication, website development. Assistance to the LPHA's regarding vaccination assistance was discussed. Lori will send Survey Monkey to LPHAs asking what they need assistance on. Rob Bukovac indicated the State is planning on doing vaccination in stages in a slow role out. Each county will receive a small amount for Healthcare workers, first responders and the elderly population. There are closed POD agreements with hospitals, jails and nursing homes. LAHCDHD is on good shape as far as POD's go.

EEI -ASPR and Regional – How do we communicate



- Discussed the importance of mass communications, websites. Discussed EMResources and how much information is duplicated or available through EMResources. Lori will research and see if we can do use EMResources to create events for the ASPR EEI communication piece and the regional EEI development and input. This would be the SRHCC communication to ASPR within 36 hours and the collection on data.
