HPP COVID-19 Funds

- Funding Part 2 - \$85,000 per HCC plus \$3000 per hospital which after the 15% to the Fiscal Agent is roughly \$87,000.
- Lori Silva mentioned that she had received two inquiries from individuals interested in taking on the COVID-19 funding II project deliverables and plans. One was from a member agency (which never responded), the other was from the San Luis Valley (SLV) as she was the HCC Coordinator and had recently been relieved of her duties. HCC Coordinator from SLV understands grant year ends in June 2021. No feedback or discussion from CPT
- Rob Bukovac discussed a scenario that occurred in which folks were traveling, had an accident and tested positive for COVID-19. They had no place to go. Could HPP funds be used for motels? Lori will contact CDPHE to see if this HPP funding can be used.
- Discussion included the purchase of tents, which Rob Bukovac reported any pop-up tents will not hold up well in the wind. Discussed the possibility of a tent that is used by the national guard. Rob Bukovac reported that his understanding is the first wave of vaccinations will go to first responders, medical personnel and nursing homes. A tent will not be needed right now as vaccine will be given to facilities for distribution.
- Justin Carbee discussed an army tent that could be put up to assist with hospital ER overflow.
- Autoclaves- Mike Lening reported that AMS does not use autoclaves. Most items used are disposable
- Battery powered Riobi-very efficient for EMS.
- PPE – Captain Toth ordered N95 masks. Toth will send Lori Silva information on PPE order.



- Justin Carbee mentioned if the SRHCC could order general face cover masks with the SRHCC logo for distribution to the general public. The masks would be issued through the health departments. Lori will ask CDPHE if grant dollars can be used for this item.

Action Items:

Lori:

- HPP Funding for use of motel rooms when there is no other alternative for COVID+ care
- Ryobi Foggers: Lori will look at prices for foggers and chemical
- 3 for each Health Department (not need every day so the Health Department could distribute accordingly) 1 for each EMS Agency, Chemical (bulk order)
- Bulk PPE order of N95 masks, gowns, gloves, regular masks (this is for the initial \$25,000- possibly order more)
- CDPHE – Motel rooms, general mask face covers with SRHCC logo
